GENERAL PROPERTY MAINTENANCE	Owners are required to maintain the exterior of homes; See specific guidelines regarding: Exterior maintenance; roof/home/driveway cleaning; house painting/ color changes; garage doors; air conditioners; mailboxes; chains and barricades; outdoor lighting; seasonal lighting; hurricane shutters; renewable energy systems; pods or temporary storage systems	
LAKES — PONDS – CANALS	No swimming; boating or fishing is allowed.	
ARC-ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW COMMITTEE	Owners shall follow established architectural standards when making changes to the exterior of their property. All changes to the exterior of the property shall be reviewed and approved by the Architectural Review Committee (ARC)	
OUTSIDE CONTRACTOR ENTRY	No outside contractors, vendors or workers are permitted in PGA Village before 7:00 AM or after 6:00 PM on weekdays and before 7:00 AM or after 5:00 PM on Saturday.	
ACCESSORY STRUCTURES	Accessory structures are not permitted on any yard, driveway, or walkway without written approval of the Maidstone ARC.	
BASKETBALL BACKBOARDS	Basketball backboards are not allowed in Maidstone.	
RECREATIONAL AND FUNCTIONAL ACCESSORIES	Recreational and functional accessories such as swing sets, jungle jims, basketball backboards and hoops, skateboard ramps, trampolines, and other large play equipment are not allowed in Maidstone. Skateboarding is not allowed anywhere in Maidstone	
CLOTHESLINES AND ANTENNAS	In an effort to encourage energy conservation, clotheslines will be permitted provided they are not visible from the streets. No Antennas may be erected which could interfere with TV, phones or computer signals.	
YARD OR GARAGE SALES	No yard or garage sales are permitted on any Parcel/Lot in Maidstone.	
VIOLATIONS OF POA DOCUMENTS AND/OR RULES AND REGULATIONS	All violations noted will receive a "notice of violation" issued by the Property Manager and are subject to review by the Dispute Committee. Non compliance may result in fees and loss of privileges.

COMPLIANCE WITH RULES AND REGULATIONS	Each Owner and resident is responsible for compliance with Maidstone Rules and Regulations by all family members, guests, visitors, and lessees.	
NUISANCE/NOXIOUS ODORS	Owners, residents, and their guests may not cause or allow an annoyance or nuisance to other residents. The use of any materials or activity that produce odors which become an annoyance or nuisance to others is prohibited.	
NO DOOR-TO-DOOR SOLICITING	This includes the distribution of flyers or correspondence of any kind placed anywhere on an owner's property or in an owner's mailbox, unless delivered by the U.S. Postal Service.	
FLAGS (PER FL STATUTE (720.00)	Owners may display one portable, removable United States flag or official flag of the State of Florida in a respectful manner. A flagpole in accordance with the Florida Statute is allowed.	
SIGNS/LIGHTING/ARTIFICIAL VEGETA- TION	No signs other than an alarm company sign. All outside light bulbs must be clear or white in color No artificial vegetation, grass or plants shall be placed on the front yard or sides of any lot.	
STORM SHUTTERS	Storm shutters are allowed to be installed after a named storm by the National Weather Service is announced until 5 days after storm passes. Accordion shutters shall be white, beige or ivory.	
ASSESSMENT PAYMENTS	Payments are due quarterly starting January 1st and each first day of subsequent quarters. Late fees will be assessed if payments are not received on time.	
BURNING/FENCES/DOG HOUSES	Burning other than on barbecue grills is not allowed. Dog houses or shelters are not permitted. Only fences around the pool are allowed.	
PARKING	No vehicle of any kind shall be parked overnight on any street between 2:00 A.M. and 7:00 A.M., Commercial vehicles may not park on driveways overnight between 2:00 AM and 7:00 AM, Parking is not allowed on any grass areas or sidewalks.	
ABUSIVE AND/OR THREATENING LANGUAGE	Abusive and/or threatening language or any inappropriate conduct directed towards individuals in the service of this community, Officers and volunteers is prohibited.	
HOLIDAY DECORATIONS	Decorations can be put up 30 days prior to a named holiday and must be removed 15 days after. Audible decorations are not allowed. Decorations should be placed in a manner not to interfere with lawn maintenance.	
T-STICKERS OR HEADLIGHT STICKERS	Owners may purchase PGA Village T-stickers or Headlight stickers which will be permanently affixed to the inside of the front windshield, or the headlight of your personal automobiles.	
REPAINTING/ROOFS	Requests for repainting must be processed thru the ARC committee. The forms required and the allowed painting pallets for home exteriors and doors are available at the Property Manager's office. Homeowners are responsible for maintaining their roofs clean.	
RENTING/LEASING PROPERTY	An Owner wishing to rent or lease his property shall complete the required forms and deposits. No subleasing is allowed. Other rules apply. Consult the governing documents.
